

Location and Mountain Stats



Mount Washington Alpine Resort is the natural choice for your next winter getaway. Fly direct from Edmonton, Vancouver, or Calgary into the Comox Valley International Airport (YQQ), 40 minutes below the resort. Or drive the Inland Island Highway right to the base of Mount Washington (exit 130). Mount Washington is located 25km west of the Comox Valley, 50km south of Campbell River, and 100km north of Nanaimo. The resort is just 3 hours north of Victoria and 3.5 hours from Vancouver, including a 90-minute cruise with the scenic BC Ferries.
